## **Trustees Honor Humelsine**

Carlisle H. Humelsine was honored during the November 15-17 weekend on the occasion of his official retirement from active involvement in Colonial Williamsburg after 32 years of leadership, first as executive vice-president and then successively as president and chairman of the foundation's board. By unanimous board of trustee action, Humelsine was elected to the honorary post of chairman emeritus.

As previously announced, Charles L. Brown, chairman of the board and chief executive officer of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, succeeded Humelsine as chairman. Abby O'Neill of Oyster Bay, N.Y. assumed the new position of vice-- chairman of the board. Mrs. O'Neill is a granddaughter of John D. Rockefeller Jr., who established Colonial Williamsburg in 1926.

## **First Endowed Chair at CW Named in Honor of Humelsine**

CW's first endowed chair supporting scholarly pursuits in the decorative arts has been named in honor of Carlisle Humelsine. The holder of the initial endowed position is Graham S. Hood, vice president and chief curator.

The chair was first supported by a \$750,000 gift, given in 1981 by trustees Abby and George O'Neill. Unnamed until now, the endowment for the Humelsine chair has grown to \$1.2 million with additional gifts from all present and former members of the

CW boards, and widows of former board members.

In her announcement of the naming of the chair, Mrs. O'Neill said: "You (Humelsine) are singularly responsible for the continuous effort through both purchase and gift to make this unique collection not only the outstanding one in this country but also one highly acclaimed abroad...We all feel that the creation of the Carlisle H. Humelsine chair both honors you and your years of dedication to Colonial Williamsburg. It also once again reaffirms Grandfather's credo for the restoration: 'that the future may learn from the past.'"

### **Do You Have Questions About Your Vacation Balance?**

Take your questions to your supervisor who will call Personnel with all questions from your area.

"Vacation Hours Available" on your paycheck stub includes any vacation left over from last year plus any vacation accrued this year.

Vacation balances do not include any service bonus (bonus vacation). Call Payroll, at extensions 2493 or 2494, if you have any questions about your service bonus balance.

A quick way to figure the amount of vacation you are accruing each pay period is to multiply the numbers of hours worked by .0385 if you have worked here less than five years, by .0577 if you have worked here more than five but fewer than fifteen, and by .0769 if you have worked here more than fifteen years.

If you earn two weeks vacation a year and you work 80 hours every pay period, you are accruing 3.08 hours every pay period. If you work 75 hours, you are accruing 2.89 hours every pay period.
