Surrounded by a 19-foot plumcolored brick wall, the garden features a trellis-shaded sitting area with blue stone accents and imposing classical columns similar to those in the Gallery.

The focal point of the garden is a rectangular reflecting pool dotted with water lilies. Two fountains grace each end. The only entrance to the garden is through the Gallery.
